Components may include:

- ✓ Review of injury statistics and worker symptoms reports

- ✓ Assessment of the equipment and tools that are used
- ✓ Assessment of the physical layout and the environmental conditions present
- ✓ Consideration of safety rules and protective equipment that may be required
- ✓ Consideration of production expectations
- ✓ Application of anthropometrics, kinesiology, human function, physiology, environmental design and ergonomic principles
- ✓ Use of research-based information regarding ergonomics and injury prevention

Ergonomic recommendations are provided in a clear concise report in three main categories:

- ✓ Environmental Controls: workstation design, tools, or equipment
- ✓ Administrative Controls: protective equipment, scheduling, task assignments
- ✓ Work Practice Controls: posture, work techniques, employee training

Ergonomic Risk Assessment Goals:

- To identify work methods, work practices or environmental conditions, which represent hazards that place workers at risk for injury
- To provide strategies and recommendations to reduce or eliminate hazards thereby reducing the risk of injury, and to improve productivity, efficiency and comfort
- To provide guidance regarding new equipment purchases, changes to the environment, or production demands
